

Accredited Summer School or Mid-year Course Recovery Program Information For Schools

What is needed from your school:

WCA requires a letter of approval from the student's school that will allow the student to complete the course for transfer credit to your school. The student's name, course to be completed, school name, school mailing address, and brief statement stating credit will be transferred from WCA if student successfully completes the course, and an authorized signature. We have provided a simple default form. This letter can be mailed or faxed to the contact information below.
